Frequently Asked Questions

What is a mobile business?

A business that is mobile in nature, including but not limited to a van, truck, utility, caravan, trailer or cart (with the exception of mobile ice-cream businesses).

Why is Council proposing to implement a policy?

After our recent busy summer holiday period, it is timely to review the process in which permits for mobile businesses are issued. The implementation of a Mobile Business Location Rules Policy will ensure a fair, balanced and consistent approach when issuing permits for mobile businesses within the Council area.

What are the current rules?

Currently, mobile food businesses can operate on community land within the Council area in accordance with 'location rules' which are determined by Council. Current location rules stipulate that mobile businesses must not operate within 50 metres walking distance of any fixed business selling the same or similar product or service during the opening hours of the fixed business.

Please note, that mobile business location rules do not apply to community events with an approved permit or traders operating from private land (these activities are exempt from any mobile business location rules policy).
