The lighting of fires in the open air is prohibited in the LOWER SOUTH EAST FIRE BAN DISTRICT from **22 November 2023 to 15 April 2024.** One exemption (see following) will be allowed without the need of a permit <u>on any day other than a TOTAL</u> <u>FIRE BAN day.</u>

ALL OTHER FIRES WILL REQUIRE A PERMIT

Information and permits can be obtained by contacting the **AUTHORISED OFFICER** listed in this brochure (see **"Burning Off Arrangements"**), or by contacting the Kingston District Council.

The one exemption, subject to local restrictions, is as follows:-

1. A FIRE FOR PREPERATION OF FOOD OR BEVERAGE MAY BE LIGHTED OR MAINTAINED PROVIDED THAT:-

- (a) the fire is contained in a properly constructed fire place, a portable cooking appliance or a trench at least 30 cm deep;
- (b) the space immediately around and above the fire is cleared of all flammable material to a distance of at least four metres;
- (c) the fire does not occupy an area in excess of one square metre;
- (d) a person who is able to control the fire is present at the site of the fire; from the time it is lighted to the time it is completely extinguished; and
- (e) an appropriate agent adequate to extinguish the fire is at hand.

(If you have permission of the Landowner).

TOTAL FIRE BAN DAY

On a Total Fire Ban day, only gas or electric appliances will be allowed within 15 metres of domestic premises or on the foreshore, subject to the conditions of 1(b), (d), and (e) above.



BURNING OFF ARRANGEMENTS

Landholders are advised that major restrictions in the lighting of fires will come into force on **22 November 2023**. A permit will be required for BURNING OFF. Permits can be obtained from the **AUTHORISED OFFICER**:

When a permit is issued (it may be issued by telephone, radio, in writing or in person) the landholder will be issued with a

STANDARD CONDITIONS FOR ISSUE OF PERMIT

- 1. The land immediately around the relevant land must be cleared of all flammable vegetation to a distance of at least four metres.
- 2. That at least 2 persons who are able to control the fire, or such greater number of persons as may be specified in the permit, must be present at the site of the fire from the time it is lighted to the time it is completely extinguished.
- 3. The fire must first be lighted from the leeward side of the relevant land to establish a protective break, and then may be lighted from the windward side of the land.
- 4. The holders of the permit must, not more than seven days, and no less than two hours, before the fire is lighted, give notice of his/her intention to light the fire:
 - To any person who owns, occupies or is in charge of land adjoining the land holding where the relevant land is situated;
 - (2) If the relevant land is inside (or partially inside) a Council area, to an Officer of the Council for that area;
 - (3) If the relevant land is within two kilometres of a government reserve, to the person in charge of the reserve, and
 - (4) To an officer of the relevant CFS Brigade.
- 5. That at least 400 litres of water, or such greater amount of water as may be specified in the permit, must be kept at hand to extinguish the fire.

ADDITIONAL LOCAL CONDITIONS

No permits for burning off for the purpose of clearing of land; will be issued between 22 November 2023 and 15 April 2024

- 1. No burning off will be permitted on Sunday, Public Holidays or Easter Saturday.
- 2. No burning off to commence before 12 noon.
- 3. The permit holder must notify the local council office and an officer of the local CFS brigade, of the actual day the permit holder intends to burn, not later than 10:00am and not more than 7 days prior to the actual day of the burn.
- 4. All fires to be out by Midnight.
- 5. Permits will not be issued without a grid reference, nearest road name, town, contact name and phone number.
