Project Scope

- ▶ Our Coorong Our Coast is a federally funded project that is delivered by the Limestone Coast Landscape Board (2018-2023)
- ▶ The primary aim is to protect beach nesting and migratory shorebirds and their habitat in the Coorong and Limestone Coast, areas which are of global significance to shorebirds
- ▶ The project delivers this through on ground works (pest plant and animal control, revegetation etc), annual bird counts, and community engagement activities (signage/workshops etc)
- ▶ The Limestone Coast Landscape Board have signs similar to the proposed Kingston ones at Port Mac and Meningie, aiming to make every visitor aware that they are in a region of high importance to shorebirds. These signs have been well received and popular in other regions
- ▶ The Board would like to have them displayed from September to March every year - this is the season that Migratory shorebirds are in our region
